Traffic Alert

Thursday, July 29 for the week of August 1 - 7, 2010

Below is a list of activity in the public right of way of which we are currently aware.

*For important updates mid-week, log onto our website at www.spokanevalley.org
and click on the "Traffic Alerts" link under "What's New."*

Barker Road Bridge over the Spokane River – is now open to traffic in both directions. The river put-in and take-out on the north bank at Barker Road remains closed. For river access, use the put-in/take-out just upstream of the bridge (approximate cross street is McMillan).

Broadway Avenue Moore to Flora Improvement Project – starts Monday August 2. Improvements include widening from two lanes to three with center turn lane, sidewalks, bicycle lanes, curbs and gutters. Also includes installation of roundabout at the intersection of Broadway & Flora.

- **Broadway Avenue between Conklin Road and Flora Road** – closed to through-traffic starting at 6:00am on Monday, Aug 2 through mid-October.
- **Broadway/Flora intersection** – closed starting at 6:00am on Monday, Aug 2 through mid-September.
- **Access to businesses in the project area remains available.**
 - Eastbound/westbound traffic may use Valleyway or Sprague.
 - Northbound/southbound traffic may use Sullivan or Barker.
 - Those whose destinations lie outside the project area may wish to use alternative routes.
 - **PLEASE NOTE: Flora Bridge over I-90** – closes Monday for **County sewer construction** project. For more details including dates/detours, log onto Spokane County's website at www.spokanecounty.org and access the Engineering and Road Division's [Current Traffic Restrictions](#)

Sprague/Sullivan reconstruction project – Project is on schedule. Barring unforeseen complications, the target date for completion is August 9.

- Intersection remains closed to through-traffic around the clock through early- to mid-August.
- Through-traffic is re-routed via Adams, Broadway, Conklin and 4th.

- **Local access to businesses on the intersection remains available.**
- Please observe the posted speed limits along the detour routes, using particular caution in residential areas where there may be pedestrians, bicyclists and traffic entering the roadway from driveways.
- Those whose destinations lie outside the project area may wish to use alternative routes.

Street Sweeping – Expect periodic maintenance sweeping at night on arterials and in commercial and industrial areas.
