

How you can help protect stormwater -

Help keep your stormwater fees low and protect water quality by following these guidelines to keep pollution out of our water:



- Use pesticides and fertilizers sparingly.
- Repair vehicle fluid leaks.
- Properly dispose of household hazardous waste (FREE to City residents) including: paints, cleaners, batteries, florescent bulbs, used vehicle fluids such as antifreeze, oil, and other items at the [Spokane Valley University Transfer Station](#) located at 2405 N. University Road or check out the [Spokane EnviroStars Waste Directory](#) for other locations and area vendors that will receive specific types of wastes.
- Clean up after your pet.
- Use a commercial car wash or wash your car on a lawn or other unpaved surface.
- Sweep up yard debris rather than hosing down areas.
- Compost or recycle yard waste when possible.
- Clean paint brushes in a sink, not outdoors.
- Properly dispose of excess paints through a household hazardous waste collection program.
- Sweep up and properly dispose of construction debris like concrete and mortar.
